### ABSTRACT

APERC – Retail Supply Tariff Order for FY 2013-14 - Revision of tariffs in respect of LT Domestic Category consumers whose monthly consumption is upto 200 units on account of additional subsidy provided by Government of Andhra Pradesh - Reg.

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### ORDER:

In respect of the ARR/tariff filings submitted by the four (4) Distribution Licensees in the state viz., APCPDCL (OP No: 04 of 2013), APEPDCL (OP No: 01 of 2013), APNPDCL (OP No: 03 of 2013) & APSPDCL (OP No: 02 of 2013), the Andhra Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission [APERC] issued Retail Supply Tariff Order for FY 2013-14, dated: 30-03-2013, duly considering the communication of the Govt. of Andhra Pradesh under Sec. 65 of the Electricity Act, 2003. In the said order, the retail supply tariffs in respect of the L.T. Domestic Category consumers, who consumes upto 200 units in a month, were notified to the public on 31.03.2013, as follows:

2) Subsequently, the Government of Andhra Pradesh vide its Letter No:GoAP (Energy Power-II)/823/Pr.II(1)/2013-3 Dt:01.05.2013, communicated the following:

*“With reference to the Tariff fixed by APERC for 2013-14, the Government has decided to keep the tariff upto 200 units of consumption by the Domestic category consumers at the level of 2012-13 only. Accordingly the tariff for domestic category consumers upto 200 units of monthly consumption will be as follows for tariff years 2013-14.*

In this regard, it has been assessed that on account of above decision of the Government, an amount of Rs. 818 Crores by way of additional subsidy would have to be reimbursed to DISCOMs and, in addition an amount of Rs. 12 Crores for similar domestic consumers served by RESCO.

In consequence of the above decision, the Government, as obligated under Section 65 of the Indian Electricity Act, 2003 has decided to bear the additional subsidy of Rs. 830 Crores.

It is further clarified that this tariff would be applicable only if consumption is upto 200 units. In respect of consumers who consume more than 200 units/month, the tariff approved by APERC in their order mentioned vide Secretary, APERC, Lr. No. APERC/Secy/EAS/RSTO2-12-13/12, dated: 21.04.2013, will be applicable.....

- 3) Considering the commitment of additional subsidy by the GoAP as above, the tariffs notified in the Retail Supply Tariff Order for FY 2013-14, in respect of LT Domestic category consumers whose monthly consumption up to 200 units, stands revised w.e.f. 01-04-2013 as given below:

6) The revised tariff in respect of LT-Domestic category consumers whose monthly consumption upto 200 units shall also be applicable to Rural Electric Co-Operative Societies (RESCOs) in the State.

7) All the Distribution Licensees are directed to notify the consumers, through a 'Public Notice', duly getting these modified tariffs published in the same newspapers, in which the Original Tariff Schedule for FY 2013-14 was got published on 31-03-2013.
